Thank you for your interest and participation in Adopt an Area. Your Certificate of Adoption for West Gator Creek Road is enclosed. Your adopted area extends from the entrance road on SR 406 (Garden Street) for a distance of 1 mile on both sides of the road.

Adopt an Area is a litter control program on Merritt Island National Wildlife Refuge patterned after the national Adopt a Road program. Since the program's inception in April 2009, volunteers have removed 1300 bags of litter and contributed 1750 hours of time.
